


# The Regional Municipality of York 2022 Budget

**\$3.7 billion** → { **\$2.7 billion** Operating costs + **\$980 million** Capital costs

The final year of a four-year budget for this term of Regional Council aligns with the **Regional Strategic Plan**.



## 2022 BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS

### Keeping people moving



**Beginning** in 2022, the budget includes capital expenditures to cover the Region's **\$1.12 billion** shared cost of the Yonge North Subway Extension.



**Providing** efficient transit through conventional bus routes, Viva bus service on dedicated rapidways and Mobility On-Request service.



**Maintaining** more than **4,300** lane-kilometres of urban and rural roads.

### York Region's COVID-19 response



**Continuing** to support COVID-19 response and recovery efforts.

### Helping create homes



**Building** affordable housing, including Unionville Commons and Stouffville housing development.

### Protecting our health



**Delivering** 120 billion litres of clean and safe drinking water annually to protect public health.



**Building** two new paramedic stations.



**Hiring** 15 York Regional Police Uniform Officers and 12 civilian staff to help keep our communities safe.

### Protecting the environment


**Leading** corporate climate change action through mitigation, adaptation and application of York Region's Energy Conservation Demand Management Plan.

**Providing** funding to the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority and the Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority to support initiatives to protect lakes, rivers and lands within our watersheds.
