

ROW	What To Do	What Not To Do
Entrance and Sign Features	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Create balance and symmetry on both sides of the road</li> <li>- Compliment and soften signage with the use of plantings</li> <li>- Drips lines in columns or posts</li> <li>- Sustainable or long lasting materials</li> <li>- Match the context of the area</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Block signage with plants that will grow to large</li> <li>- Block sight lines i.e. not comply with sight triangle design manual</li> <li>- Poorly designed columns or caps that will deteriorate or break down over time ex. bricks to close to salt spray or structures that don't drain properly.</li> </ul> 
Utilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Buffer unsightly utilities with hard or softscape while maintaining maintenance access</li> <li>- Recommend Hydro Burial in Urban Corridors and Centres</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Design with no consideration for unsightly infrastructure</li> <li>- Proposed items with deep footings above underground utilities</li> <li>- Obstruct maintenance access to utilities</li> </ul> 

<p>Slopes and Ditches</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- integrate bio swales where feasible and sensible</li> <li>- Wired and burlapped trees only on 3:1 slopes if planted on 2:1 slopes tree planting areas must be terraced</li> <li>- Shrubs and small trees can be planted on 2:1 slopes</li> <li>- Where possible implement vegetated swales opposed to rip rap</li> </ul>  	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Trees on 2:1 slopes eventually will fail/uproot and are a hazard</li> <li>- Over engineered ditches with limited to no vegetation</li> </ul>  
<p>Splash Pads</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Concrete/ Coloured and unit paver splash pads on all urban cross section</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Asphalt or no splash pads in urban cross section</li> </ul> 

Plantings i.e. Shrubs, Trees Grasses Perennials etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Plantings with symmetry and different heights, species etc.</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- No Plantings</li> <li>- Sporadic plantings with no symmetry or theme</li> <li>- Aggressive or invasive species that will spread and kill other plants over time</li> </ul> 
Enhanced Paving in Boulevards i.e. Unit Pavers, Coloured Concrete etc.		
Street Furniture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- street furniture that matches the context of the area</li> <li>- Long lasting materials</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- No Street Furniture</li> </ul>
