


MANUAL DISHWASHING THREE-SINK METHOD

for multi-service articles



*** Contact time must be at least 45 seconds**

Use clean hot water at least 77°C (170°F) **OR** mix clean water no colder than 24°C (75°F) with chlorine to make a 100 parts per million (ppm) solution. You can use 2 ml (approximately 1/2 teaspoon) of household bleach (5.25% chlorine) with 1 litre (4 cups) of water **OR** use quaternary ammonium to make a mixture no weaker than 200 ppm (follow the instructions on the product label) **OR** use iodine to make a mixture no weaker than 25 ppm (follow the instructions on the product label).
